

"FAICM Child Sponsorship Scheme"

African International Christian Ministry, our partner organisation in Uganda, works with many poor, needy children in rural communities in which it serves. Often they are single or double orphans and some are from tribal settlements that face much discrimination and hardship. The Ugandan government does not fund secondary education. School fees are impossible for many of these children and in addition, money is needed for uniform, equipment and boarding. Will you and/or a group of friends consider helping us to send these children to school? There are three ways you can support these children through our Sponsorship scheme:

- 1) Sponsors can fund an individual child through secondary education to GCSE standard for four to six years.

Many secondary pupils drop out of school as their families are too poor to pay the fees and often the students are too hungry to study and lack funds for uniform, stationery and school meals. Many suffer illnesses; malaria and diarrhoea, and families cannot afford medication for them. Most of them live in dismal conditions. Some sponsors group together to pay a regular amount to our Sponsorship Fund. This helps FAICM to top up school fees to enable many orphans to remain in secondary education, as well as providing unexpected medical care.

AICM College of Science and Technology is acquiring an excellent reputation, offering many courses, including practical skill-based subjects, such as agriculture, computing and accounting, hotel management, catering, plumbing and tailoring, for students not wishing to take "A" level exams.

It offers young people a chance to learn skills that will enable them to earn a living. However, when they have finished their courses, many lack the funds to equip themselves with tools for their trade.

Sponsors give money towards purchasing plumbing tools, sewing machines, and items for catering and other professions. Kits can cost from £100 to £200.
