

Friends of African International Christian Ministry Secondary School sponsorship for vulnerable children



Would you open a door of opportunity for one of these youngsters?



African International Christian Ministry (AICM) works among some of the poorest communities in Uganda. Children in these communities may be lucky enough to attend a primary

school, but they have no hope of accessing secondary education. Whilst government universal secondary education is beginning in Uganda, in practice it is not yet available for many. There are insufficient schools, insufficient staff and top up fees are always necessary. For young people in the rural areas like those served by AICM, secondary education is inaccessible unless a student can find considerable fees. YOU can help . You can offer a young person the chance of a lifetime by offering sponsorship for his or her secondary education.

Secondary School Sponsorship through Friends of AICM

Sponsoring secondary education for a vulnerable child through Friends of AICM is easy and such a worthwhile contribution to the life of a needy young person.

AICM will ensure that only the most needy are put forward for sponsorship. These may include young people without one or both parents, but all of them have very little chance of a secondary education without help, and AICM maintains contact with the guardian or extended families. AICM also selects the schools with care, has good contact with head teachers and undertakes regular visits to students. Currently three schools are preferred, but AICM will select the appropriate school to suit the needs of each young person. As a sponsor you will receive a photo of your student with details of age and name. The photo will be updated as the student moves through school. You

will also receive regular progress updates.

The sponsorship rates have been carefully worked out to cover not only school fees but also other necessary extras such as uniform, school equipment, boarding fees, and transport.

Bear in mind that we are seeking to support families who have very little.

Over the years visitors have met many grateful

young people whose lives have been transformed through the kind sponsorship of a Friend in the UK. They are always grateful, never forgetting their sponsors, whom they often regard as parents.

Through Friends of AICM via monthly sponsorship, there are three different ways of supporting a young person's secondary schooling.

- 1) **Sponsor four years of secondary education** - from senior 1 to senior 4 up to "O" level standard.

Monthly sponsorship cost £30

- 2) **Sponsor two years of further education** - this will be a choice of sixth form education up to "A" level standard,
OR

Two years technical education - up to certificate level.

For the latter, there are two main course categories offered at the AICM College of Science and technology. These cover either various technical subjects, or business studies.

Monthly sponsorship cost £35



- 3) **One year vocational course** - for a young person who has had very little or no formal primary education.

This course is available in a number of subjects at the AICM College of Science and Technology and will equip students with practical skills such as hairdressing, catering, carpentry, brick laying, plumbing, tailoring, and electrical installation.

AICM has many young people applying for this course. They may have missed out on primary education, had it interrupted or failed to complete it. They will be amongst the most needy and are without the means to pay. This one year course will open a door of opportunity for these students.
